NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT, a special election of the qualified voters of the Belgium-Cold Springs Fire District in the Town of Lysander, Onondaga County, New York, will be held at the Fire Station #1, at 7920 River Road, Baldwinsville, New York 13027 in the Town of Lysander, New York, in said Fire District, on the 5th day of August 2025, between the hours of 6:00 o'clock P.M. and 9:00 o'clock P.M., prevailing time, for the purpose of voting by ballot on the adoption or rejection of the following resolution:

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS OF THE FIRE DISTRICT, TOWN OF LYSANDER, ONONDAGA COUNTY, NEW YORK, TO SELL OR OTHERWISE DISPOSE OF PERSONAL PROPERTY OF THE FIRE DISTRICT CONSISTING OF A 2015 AERIAL TRUCK, WHICH VEHICLE IS NO LONGER NECESSARY FOR ANY OF THE USES OR PURPOSES OF THE DISTRICT AT SUCH TIME, AND UPON SUCH TERMS AND CONDITIONS AS THE BOARD IN ITS DISCRETION MAY DETERMINE; SAID MONIES REALIZED THEREFROM TO BE USED TO FUND OTHER APPARATUS AND/OR EQUIPMENT PURCHASES AS DETERMINED BY THE BOARD.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Belgium Cold Springs Fire District in the Town of Lysander, Onondaga County, New York, as follows:

Section 1. The Board of Fire Commissioners is of the opinion that the present Aerial Truck is no longer needed and the District needs to replace outdated equipment such as SCBA and the sale of this apparatus could fund all or part of that purchase or other necessary equipment.

Section 2. That it is determined that the monies to be received from the sale of the Aerial Truck may exceed \$100,000.00.

Section 3. Pursuant to Section 6-g Subdivision 5 of the General Municipal Law, any monies received therefrom shall be paid into such Equipment Reserve Fund.

Section 4. This resolution is adopted subject to a mandatory referendum.
